The Boys Leadership Alliance (BLA) program grew out of a community need for structured informal educational programs for boys. The program is an informal education program that utilizes the game of football as a metaphor to teach leadership, entrepreneurship, media and economic literacy as well as life and social skills to young men. Coaches utilize evidence-based curriculums to help boys and young men develop skills and knowledge needed to confront life's challenges and lead successful productive lives.

The program is gender-specific to the needs of boys and young men that focus on informal education and the challenges of growing up male. The collaborative partnership with Girls Incorporated of the Greater Peninsula meets the need of families who require before and after school needs for children within the same household. The partnership affords families the opportunity to benefit from gender-specific structured programs at the same location.



BLA is committed to making STEM come to life for boys. Each week your child will participate in hands-on science experiments, meet people in the STEM fields and learn that STEM can be fun! Our fun Fridays include STEM components, teaching boys that science and math are not boring.

Tuition

Tuition for the program is \$40 per week (\$80 per week for both Before and After School programs). This fee must be paid every Friday for the following week. This fee is refundable if the child does not attend for the week. Check, money order, cash, and credit cards are accepted. Free USDA breakfast, dinner and snack are provided daily.

Registration

There is a \$25 non-refundable registration fee per child. A copy of the child's most recent physical examination and shot record are required. At registration your child's birth certificate and social security card must be verified.
